Why Langley City?

Langley City is where small-town charm meets big-event potential. Right in the heart of Metro Vancouver, it's easy to get here, whether you are driving in on Highway 1, hopping on public transit, or cycling along one of the city's bike-friendly routes.

Even though it covers just 10 square kilometres, Langley City packs a lot into a small space. You will find over 346 acres of parkland, six unique neighbourhoods, and a downtown that's both vibrant and walkable. There is no shortage of great places to eat, shop, and explore, and with more than 270 hotel rooms across four main properties, there is plenty of space for teams, officials, and fans to stay.

Planning a grassroots tournament or an innovative niche sport festival? Langley City has the facilities, flexibility, and local support to help your event succeed. Local sports clubs are keen to get involved, the community is welcoming, and your event won't be lost in the shuffle — it'll be part of something special.

Penzer Action Park

4748 200 St, Langley, BC V3A 6C5

This park features **dirt jumps and wooden ramps for mountain bike** enthusiasts and is extremely popular with riders of all skill levels from beginners to experts.

You can also find one of the largest **parkour parks** in Canada (10,000 square feet), a **pump track** and **two bike rack areas**.

This action-packed space also includes a **fully-fenced court** for basketball and ball hockey, a playground and four picnic tables.

Washrooms are available next to the fenced court as well as on the south-east corner of the park along 200th Street. They are typically open seasonally from April 1 and September 1, but access can be arranged outside of this period for special events.

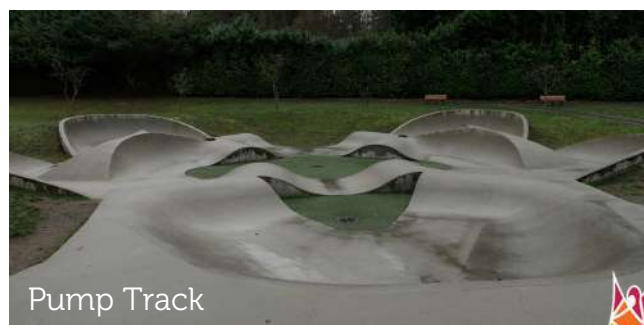
Two parking lots are available to the west of Penzer Park along 198th Street.

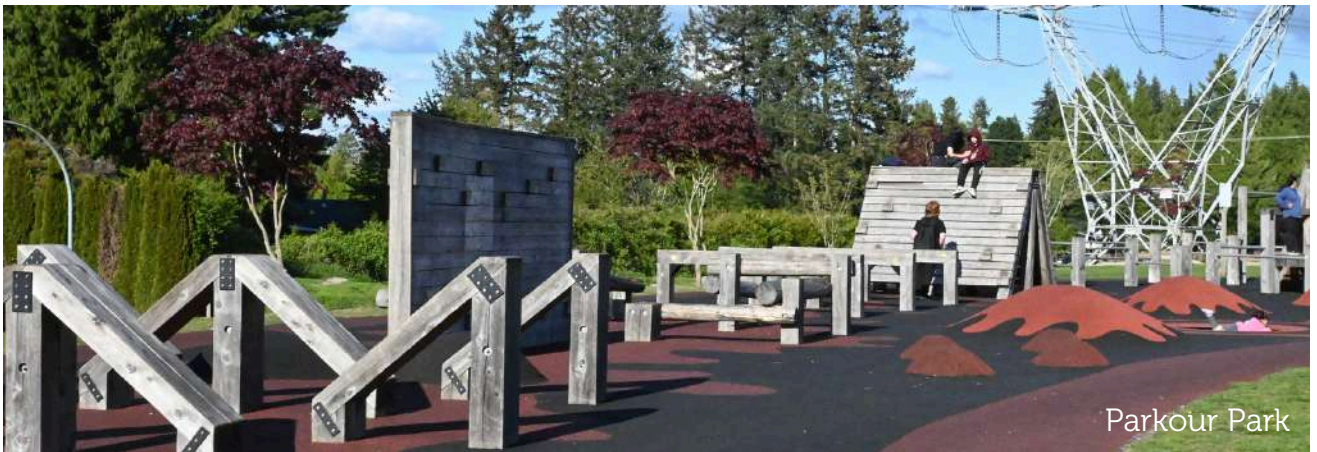

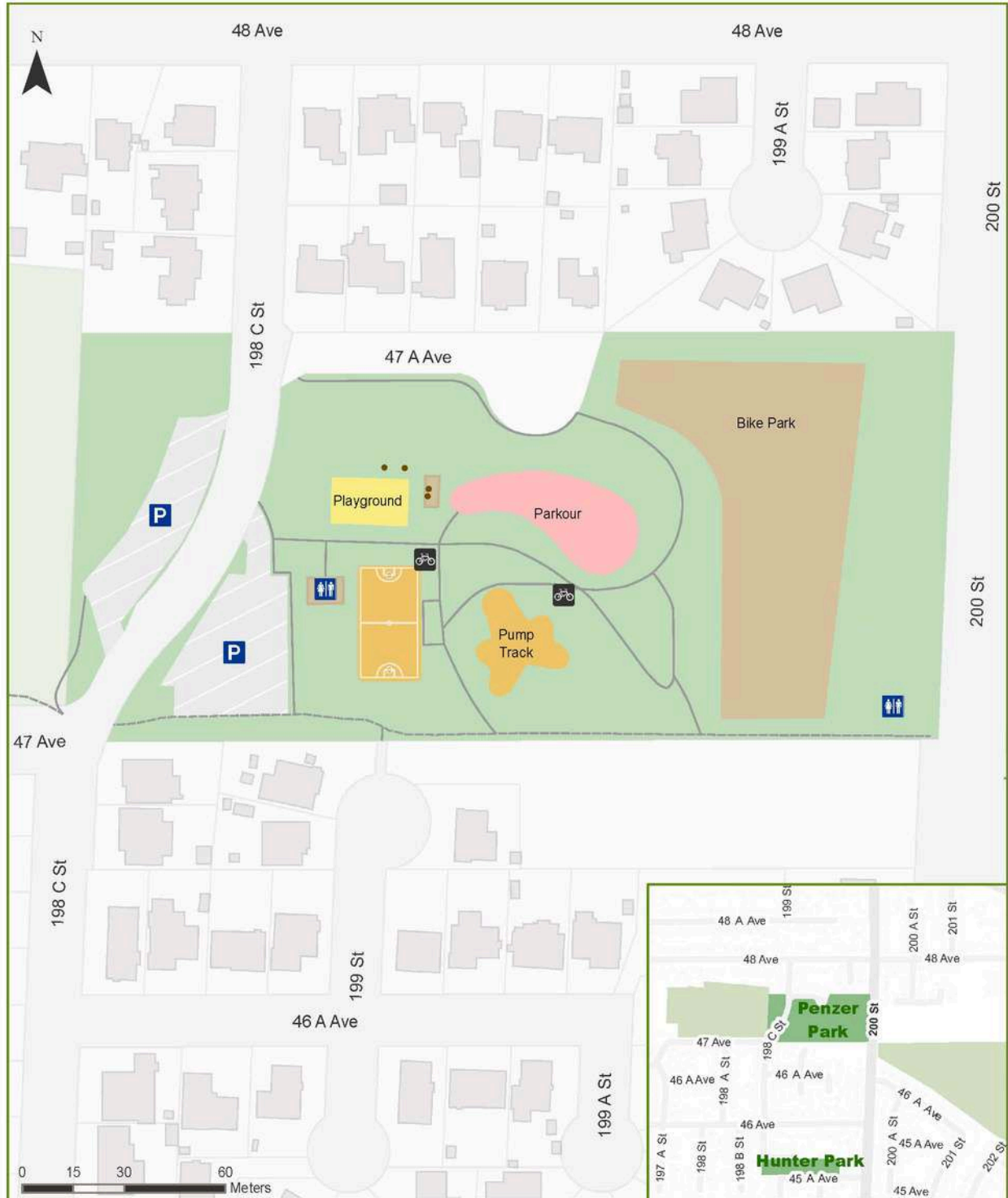

City Park

4949 207 St, Langley, BC V3A 6Z1

This park is a favourite among locals and offers a wide range of attractions, including the **Al Anderson Memorial Pool**, a children's waterpark, an off-leash dog area, and a dinosaur-themed playground. Additional amenities include a **lacrosse box**, 15 picnic tables, three covered picnic shelters, and spacious grassy areas perfect for relaxing or playing.

A single accessible washroom stall is available on-site and is typically open seasonally from April 1 to September 1. However, washroom access can be arranged outside of this period for special events.

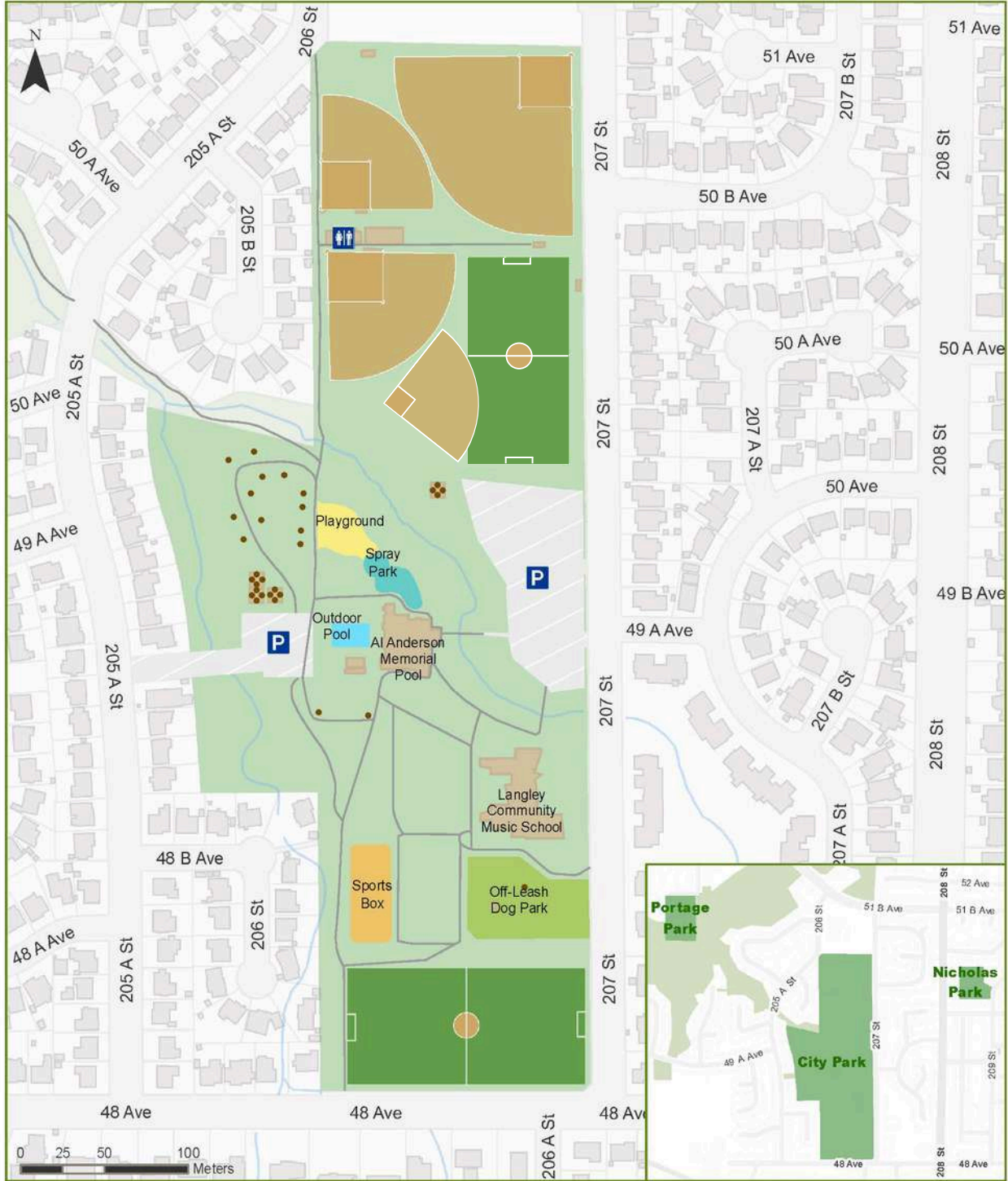
At the south end of the park, you will find a **soccer/cricket grass playfield** facing 48 Avenue. The north end, adjacent to Blacklock Elementary School, features **four baseball diamonds**. For convenient access, paved parking lots are located on 205A Street and 207 Street, or at the school.

The three covered picnic shelters, each accommodating up to 30 people, are available for booking. Parking for shelter users is accessed via the lane in the 4900 block of 205A Street.

Timms Community Centre

Timms Community Centre features a 7,500 square-foot **gymnasium**, a 120-metre (5,000 square-foot) **fitness track**, a 4,000 square-foot **weight room**, and a 2,000 square-foot **games room**. Additional facilities include a **fitness room**, a small **fitness/dance room**, a **spin bike room**, three multi-purpose rooms, a community kitchen, café, and both social lounge spaces and alcoves. The gymnasium has either **two basketball courts**, **six pickleball or badminton courts**, or **two volleyball courts**, and includes a **102-seat bleacher**.

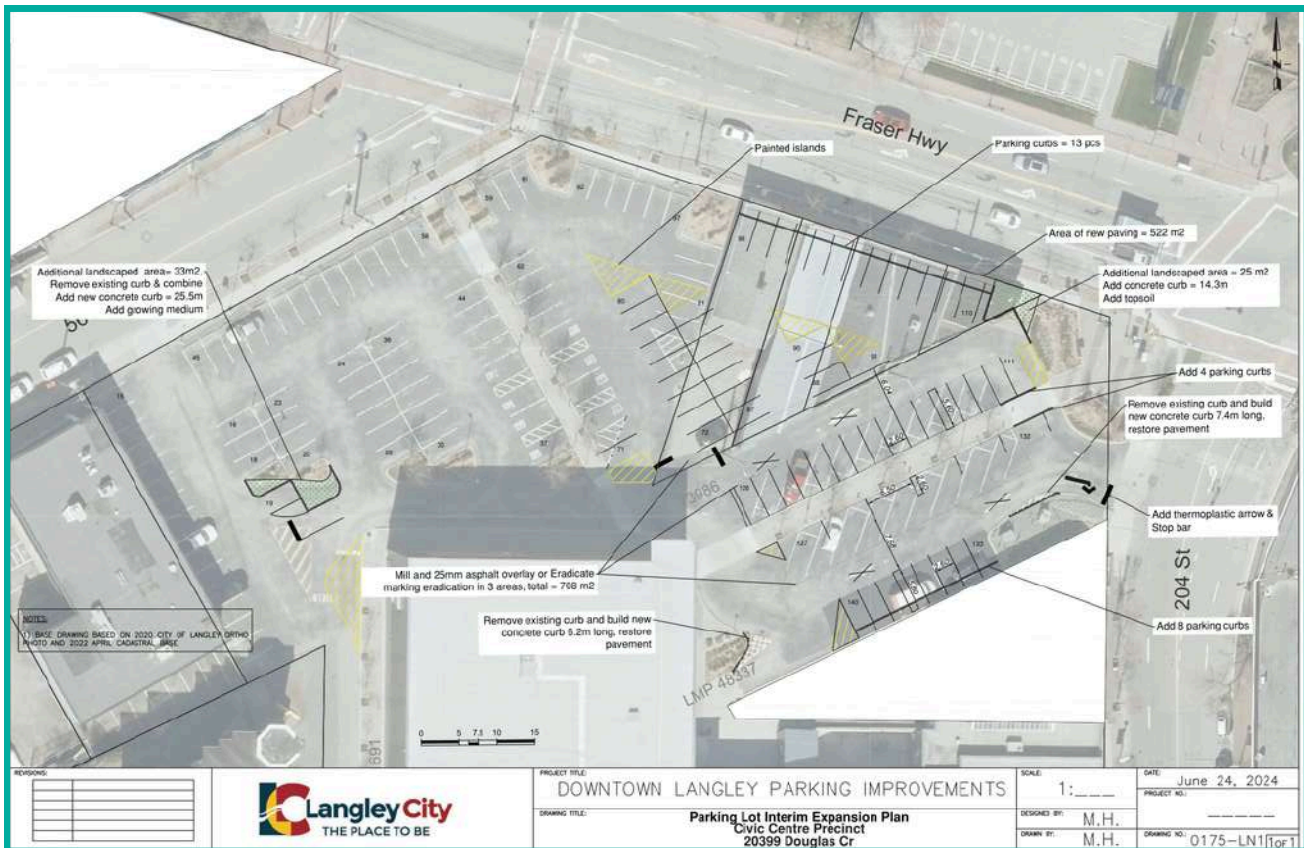
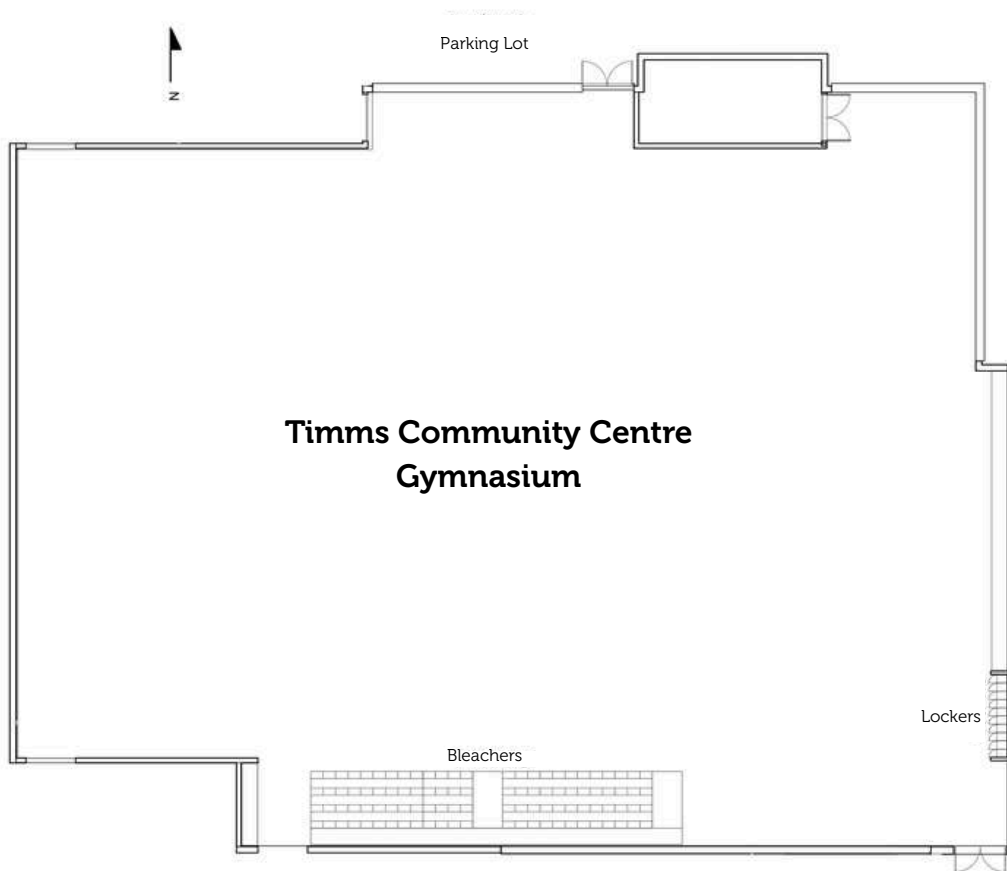
For convenience and accessibility, the centre also offers an enclosed outdoor recreation area, bike rack areas, change rooms, and washrooms.

- **Women's change room:** two shower stalls and one toilet.
- **Men's change room:** two shower stalls and one toilet.
- **Women's washroom:** eight stalls (one accessible).
- **Men's washroom:** three stalls (one accessible) and two urinals.
- **Accessible washroom and shower.**

Office and community spaces are also available.

Parking includes 133 surface level stalls and 20-30 underground stalls.

By Bicycle

- Langley City is recognized as an accessible and bike-friendly community, offering a mix of dedicated bike lanes, multi-use paths, and scenic gravel and paved trails. The city's flat terrain makes cycling easy for all ages and skill levels, whether you're commuting, sightseeing, or training.
- Cyclists can ride through vibrant downtown streets to explore local shops and restaurants, or follow one of the city's three established bike routes to visit parks, gardens, and green spaces. Langley City also connects seamlessly to neighbouring communities like the Township of Langley and Surrey, expanding the possibilities for longer rides and regional events.
- With its interconnected trail network, rest stop potential, and continued infrastructure upgrades, Langley City is an ideal host for bike-centric events, including Gran Fondo-style rides.

By Vehicle

- Coming East from Vancouver: From Hwy. 1, take exit 58 for 200th St. S, stay left in the exit lanes, and continue South down 200th Street, turning left on Fraser Hwy.
- Coming West from Fraser Valley: From Hwy. 1, take exit 66 for BC-10 W, keep right and follow signs for 232 St/BC-10 W, then continue straight onto Glover Rd.

By Public Transit

Portage Park Loop

Start at Portage Park

- > Right on 203 St., right onto Fraser Hwy. towards Downtown Langley One-Way.
- > View Langley City's murals while biking through Downtown Langley.
- > Right on 206 St., enter Nicomekl Trail south.
- > Continue southwest on Nicomekl Trail to arrive back at Portage Park.

Nicomekl Bike Trail

Start at Brydon Lagoon (paved route)

- > Follow Nicomekl Trail east.
- > Detour to Sendall Gardens, right on 201A St., left at 50 Ave.
- > Follow Nicomekl Trail east towards Portage Park.
- > Enter Nicomekl Trail east, then turn right towards and through City Park.
- > Follow Nicomekl Trail back west to arrive back at Brydon Lagoon.

Langley City Loop

Start at Portage Park (primarily gravel route)

- > Follow Pleasandale Creek Trail south. > Turn right onto Powerline Trail - east, cross 200 St. to Penzer Action Park.
- > Follow Powerline Trail - west.
- > Enter the trail off Buckley Park, then take the first right turn on the trail into the woods. Continue straight on.
- > Keep right on the trail path after the wooden bridge walkway.

- > Carefully cross Colebrook Rd., and enter the trail in Hi-Knoll Park in Surrey on the other side of the road. Continue straight on.
- > Once at the end of this path, turn right on the trail to arrive at Brydon Lagoon.
- > Follow 53 Ave., left on 203 St., right on Douglas Cres.
- > View Langley City's murals while biking through Downtown.
- > Right on 206 St., and enter Nicomekl Trail heading west to arrive back at Portage Park.

 - DLC logo must be on event signage and must be approved by the DLC team prior to display. Tag @discoverlangleycity on Instagram and Facebook to share our sponsorship.

Third Tier - \$1,500

- Catered towards small community events, such as sporting tournaments.
- Requirements we ask of you:
 - DLC logo must be on event signage and must be approved by the DLC team prior to display. Tag @discoverlangleycity on Instagram and Facebook to share our sponsorship.

Please note: All events must take place in the City of Langley to be eligible to receive sponsorship dollars.
